

A Few Gentle Reminders

We would just like to remind all residents of a few things that would greatly help the Sussex Heights Dream Team during this time.

Rubbish

Please put your rubbish in proper tied bin bags.

Due to the Coronavirus epidemic we need to ask everyone to put all your rubbish AND recycling in strong plastic bags and make sure they are properly tied.



Also could we please ask residents to assist by:

- Flattening ALL plastic bottles and ALL cardboard boxes as much as is possible.
- Making all rubbish as compact as can be due to lack of space.
- Taking your own rubbish to the bins when you can.

Deliveries

When a courier buzzes your flat via an entry phone, please ask them to leave your delivery in reception. A volunteer will then deliver to your door and knock to let you know it is there.

However, if you have a food delivery, this should be brought straight up by the delivery person.
